FROM THE CHAIRMAN

Dear Friend,

In this first issue as Editor and Chairman of IFMG, I wish to extend a very warm welcome to all readers. During my Editorship I intend to write short editorials about our association. If our magazine is to be good and interesting, I beg one of you to decide to take my place as Editor. Meanwhile I should be delighted if anyone wants to contribute with a "Letter to the Editor". Similarly, I would welcome any suggestions about the newsletter or about our Fellowship in general. And now a few words about:

[a] What we have done.

Supported the WFA General Coordinator Graham Money, the new Rotary International Fellowship (of Friends of) Magna Graecia (IFMG) was officially approved in March 1994. The first message in our magazine must be our sincere and grateful thanks to him and our best wishes for his period of office as General Coordinator of Fellowships! Thank you too to the PDG Ivan N. Kaldor, who illustrated Fellowships to me and guided me in every step, and to PDG Edgar Scherer, Foreign Correspondent for the Italy-Germany Inter-Country Committee, who gave me valuable advice. The inaugural meeting was held in Melfi on April 28th 1995 during our first tour-meeting "The Castles of Emperor Frederick II". Five Governors from three nations were present with officers and members of IFMG (67 including spouses) who mingled with the group of participants (56 from 6 nations). That experience and the international tour-meeting. during which Rotarian friendship was the order of the day, has proved without doubt that the IFMG concept can provide the opportunity for the development of new friendships and for a better understanding of the way of life of other nations. The Fellowship has aroused considerable interest. Consequently, many new members better our

Fellowship and requests for information about IFMG have been received from Rotarians worldwide. This was a wonderful start!

[b] What we aim to do:

- After the success of the first, two further "international tour-meetings" are being planned for 1996 with the same criteria as the first (see details below).
- Members are invited to send suggestions about the organization of the tours.
- Because I am already over-worked, we will need more volunteers to reply to letters and requests for information. For the moment.... sorry for the delay!
- We need someone to design a campaign to publicize our existence to the Rotary Family world-wide, someone who can contribute with reports in the Rotarian press in different countries. Please come forward if you can help in any way.
- We also need money, of course, but the IFGM can count on the permanent backing decided by the Grand Tour Project Foundation: an organisation recently founded by a group of southern Italian Rotarians and of which I am the Founder-President. This Foundation aims to further Southern Italian culture in foreign countries.

I am sure you will appreciate our initiatives and not miss the opportunity to discover, once again, this area which was discovered during the Romantic "Grand Tour d'Italie", when that journey was regarded as a return to the classical world and a return to nature. We look forward to hearing from you and we remain at your disposal for any further information.

1996 PROGRAM:

[a] 25-30 April: Tour-meeting: "Frederick II's Castles"

The itinerary was planned with the members of the Fellowship of Magna Graecia in the area (RC Andria-Castelli Svevi, Bari Ovest, Barletta, Melfi, Molfetta, Taranto and Trani). These clubs will help the tour-participants to appreciate the archeological sites and the masterpieces of Norman-Swabian architecture. They will organize special meetings so that participants can taste the food and wine of the region in the warm atmosphere of Rotarian hospitality.

For the six-day (five-night) tour proposed, we have obtained special rates from the Hotel Salsello. The provisional cost of the package, per person, will be Lit. 920.000 in a double room; the supplement for a single room is Lit. 60.000. The price includes accommodation, all meals, transportation by coach during the whole stay and a French-speaking guide.

Herewith you will find a reservation form that should be returned to the Hotel Salsello as soon as possible, together with deposit of Lit 100.000 per room (not returnable if reservation is cancelled). On receipt of the reservation, the Hotel will be able to confirm the cost and we will mail a detailed programme of the itinerary with brochures of the sites to be visited. [b] 20-26 May: Tour-meeting: "Doric Temples and Baroque Monasteries".

The itinerary has been planned with our Fellowship members from the Rotary Clubs of Battipaglia, Cava de' Tirreni, Sala Consilina, Salerno Est and Salerno Valle del Picento who will work together and take part personally in the tour, as in the Frederick II Tour. The itinerary has been chosen to include archaeological and architectural treasures set in breath-takingly beautiful scenery between unspoilt Cilento and the divine Amalfi coast:

- Poseidonia (Paestum for the Romans): with its three Doric temples and the finds in the National Museum, which huoses Magna Graecia's most remarkable archeological remains;
- Velia, where Greek genius expressed the most creative work of human the mind;
- Padula, with its immense baroque Charterhouse;
- Maiori, where, when most tourists have left, on free evenings you can appreciate the charm
 of the Costiera with its peaceful churches and picturesque houses in this small town.
 Traditionally good food and wine contribute to an unforgettably relaxing atmosphere.

For the seven-day (six-night) two-centre tour proposed, we have obtained special rates from the Hotel Clorinda. The provisional cost of the package - 3 nights at the Hotel Clorinda, Paestum, and 3 nights at the Hotel Pietra di Luna, Maiori - per person, will be Lit.1,080,000 in double room; single room supplement is Lit. 60,000. The price includes accommodation, all meals, coach transport during all excursions and a German-speaking guide. Herewith you will find a reservation form that should be returned only to the Hotel Clorinda as soon as possible, together with a deposit of Lit. 100,000 per room (not returnable if reservation is cancelled). On receipt of the reservation, the Hotel will be able to confirm the cost and we will mail a detailed programme of the itinerary with brochures of the sites to be visited. MAGNA GRECIA International Fellowship



Dear Rotarian,

I would like to inform you about a new World Fellowship, Magna Graecia (IFMG). It aims to bring together Rotarians keen on history, heritage and archaeology who are particularly interested in Southern Italy: Magna Graecia.

Members of the Fellowship will receive detailed documentation (both printed matter and videotapes) on the history, art, natural environment and ethnic and social aspects of various sites of Magna Graecia.

A cultural tour with a different chosen theme will be promoted every year with local Rotarians as guides. The tour must have a specific theme because of the complexity of the historical sites in a region which for several millenia has been the cross-road of exchanges between North and South, East and West. Every site reveals traces of the great civilisations which have followed on, one after another, for almost 3,000 years, very often in areas of outstanding beauty.

Nowadays history and nature together in this part of Italy form something which is unique in the Western world. A journey to these shores has always been regarded as a return to the classical world and a return to nature, with the Mediterranean sun, the sea, vegetation and mouth-watering produce.

These considerations justify the Magna Graecia Project, which offers Rotarians cultural tourism for the élite.

The tour, promoted, prepared and guided by Rotarian friends with a common interest in Magna Graecia, could become an annual event in the international Rotary calendar.
